THE **PACIFIC OYSTER-**(Support of our economy or a threat to our *National Park?*)

Pacific oysters from Japan were deliberately introduced into European waters (Sylt 1986) to revive the oyster stock. The warming of the Wadden Sea has created a favorable condition for these oysters to reproduce rapidly.

- •Size ranges between 8cm and 20cm
- •Two valves unequal in size
- •Grows on all hard substrates in the tidal zone

- no natural enemy for the oyster was introduced therefore
- they have competitive advantage over mussels
- Increases exponentially
